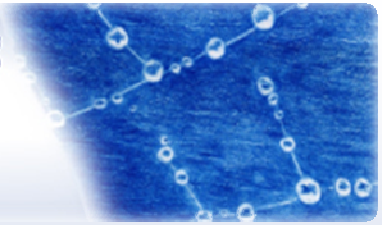

The problem:

- Fog-collecting nets need constant maintenance,
- they are unnatural, made of artificial materials,
- impair the landscape
- and are not very efficient.

The solution:

Pinus canariensis.

- A tree, perfectly created for collecting fog water
- with an extremely large surface of rough, long needles, naturally designed for the condensation of air humidity,
- self-sustaining and easy to control.
